

Introduction to High Fidelity Simulation in Healthcare Seminar

The purpose of this course is to introduce the registered nurse or other healthcare provider educator to the basic principles of simulation training utilizing high fidelity mannequins. This one day seminar will provide a "snapshot" into all aspects of high fidelity simulation, including history, simulation resources, scenario writing, technical considerations, creating reality, and debriefing.

Objectives:

1. Discuss the history of high fidelity simulation in healthcare.
2. Discuss the resources available for simulation faculty.
3. Define adult learning theory within the context of healthcare simulation.
4. List key elements in writing a simulation scenario.
5. Discuss strategies to improve realism within a simulation scenario.
6. Identify key features of human patient simulators.
7. Demonstrate key elements necessary to facilitate a simulation scenario, including debriefing skills.
