

## *Facilitating Learning with High Fidelity Simulation*

---

**The purpose of this course is to further enhance the facilitation and debriefing skills of the registered nurse or other healthcare educator experienced with high fidelity simulation. This one-day seminar will review the basic principles of simulation and focus on facilitating a simulation event. Participants will be given several opportunities to "facilitate" a simulation event and practice their debriefing skills.**

### **Objectives:**

1. Define facilitation and debriefing.
2. Define reflective practice and active listening.
3. Discuss key elements in establishing an engaging learning environment.
4. Discuss key elements in maintaining an engaging learning environment.
5. List the (3) phases of the debriefing process.
6. Discuss strategies to engage participants in the debriefing process.
7. Demonstrate methods to improve learner performance.
8. Facilitate a high fidelity simulation scenario.
